Advanced Trainee in Geriatric Medicine– 2 positions [part-time; job share or full-time]

The Advanced Trainees role comprise a mixture of inpatient, community and clinic based duties within the Geriatric Medicine Service and Sub-Acute Services. The role will be negotiated with the suitable applicant to ensure a fulfilling and rewarding position that meets their training needs. There are no regular after-hours responsibilities. You are not required to do-on-call, so the **evenings and week-ends are your own!**

Ballarat Health Service has **two positions** for an Advanced Trainee in Geriatric Medicine in 2023. Ballarat is well known for its role in Australia's history and its surrounding areas offers an escape from the hustle and bustle of life with modern city living, excellent schools and affordable housing. Ballarat has a population of in excess of 101,000 people and is Victoria's 3rd largest city and is only an hour away from Melbourne.

Ballarat Health Services operates the Ballarat Base Hospital, the largest regional hospital in the Grampians region. The sub-acute service is based at the Queen Elizabeth Centre comprising – Inpatient Complex Care Unit – 20 beds; Rehabilitation Ward – 30 beds; Palliative Care Ward – 11 beds. We also provide Transition Care Program, Restorative Care; Geriatric Medicine in the Home, Residential-in-Reach, an GEM-on-Acute, Consulting Service, Acute Liaison Service and home based visits through the Aged care Assessment Service. Our ambulatory clinics include: Dementia and Memory (CDAMS) Clinic; Continence Clinic and a Falls Clinic.

We are accredited with the Royal Australasian College of Physicians (RACP) to provide core training in Geriatric Medicine and are part of the Western Training Alliance. We offer our trainees a bespoke year to meet their professional, personal and training needs.

Our emphasis is on developing the professional skills required for becoming a junior consultant. We offer opportunities to actively participate in research and placements with the Office of the Public Advocate.

To apply:

Ballarat Health participates in the centralised match for Advanced Trainees in Geriatric Medicine in Victoria. All advanced training positions will be appointed through the centralised match.

For 2023, applicants will need to apply to both Ballarat Health as well as to the Post Graduate Medical Council of Victoria Matching Service (PMCV).
