Centralised Match for continuing trainees

update 12th July 2022

Thursday 14th July at 5PM is the deadline (closing date) for candidates in the centralised match to:

- delete or reorder existing Health Service preferences (no new Health Services may be added at this stage)
- withdraw from Match

After this date, the results of the match will be binding on both applicants and health services

Ensure that all details in your application are correct.

Participation in the match does not guarantee an appointment. Include an adequate number of Health Services on your preference list to optimise your prospects of success.

Do not include any Health Services where you would not be prepared to work, as the results of the match are binding.

Part-time and Job-share applicants.

If you have already secured employment for 2023 you must withdraw from the match.

Failure to withdraw may result in you being bound to accept a position in the match.

If you have not secured a position beforehand, then you may participate in the match, understanding that it is for full-time positions.

Match results will be available at 10AM on Thursday 28th July on the PMCV website (login required).

The second round of the centralised match opens on 2nd August.
