



Centralised Match for Advanced Training in Geriatric Medicine in 2023

The centralised match for Advanced Training in Geriatric Medicine opens on Tuesday 2nd August. Applications will be accepted for trainees entering Advanced Training in Geriatric Medicine for the first time, trainees from other RACP specialities, and trainees who were not matched in the first round.

The Postgraduate Medical Foundation of Victoria (PMCV) will run the match on behalf of VGMTTP and RACP. It is a single match for multiple RACP specialities.

All full-time positions in Geriatric Medicine will be appointed through the centralised match. Part-time and job-share positions may be appointed outside the match. Any trainee who is unable to secure a part-time position prior to the deadline may enter the second round match on the understanding that it is for a full-time position.

The match for is competitive. There is no guarantee that every applicant will secure an Advanced Training position. The outcome of the match is binding on both applicants and health services. Ensure that you have carefully read and understood the rules of the match.

To participate in the match you must:

- Submit an application for employment with each Health Service of interest

- You cannot be matched unless for have applied to both PMCV and the Health Services
- Please note closing dates vary between Health Services, and between Health Services and PMCV
