



Centralised Match Communiqué 14th July 2020

20th July 2020 is the closing date

- for registration to participate in the match
- to nominate your referees
- for you to select Health Services

Ensure that you have completed the registration process prior to 20th July 2020. After the closing date you will not be able to select a Health Service or nominate referees. Selection of a Health Service will permit the site coordinator to see your application and referees' reports. Your order of preference remains confidential.

You may withdraw from the match at any time up until the 3rd August 2020.

You will have until 3rd August 2020 to finalise your preference list. You are not required to include all selected Health Services in your final preference list.

After 3rd August 2020 your preference list will become final.

The results of the match will be binding. Once matched, you will not be able to participate in a match for another RACP specialty program as outlined in the Code of Conduct.

To optimise your prospects of securing an accredited position in 2021 you are encouraged to apply widely. The onus is on you. You cannot be matched to a vacant position in a Health Service where you have not applied or ranked in your final preference list. There is no guarantee that all trainees will gain employment.

Registration with PMCV is only one part of the matching process. You must also submit an application for employment with every Health Service where you wish to be considered. Do not apply to a Health Service where you would not be prepared to work.
