Advanced Training in Geriatric Medicine in Victoria in 2021**

Advanced Trainees

- At this stage it is too late for you to add additional Health Services to your preference list.
- The deadline for amending your ranking of Health Services is **3rd August 2020**.
- You are encouraged to list an adequate number of sites on your final preference ranking to optimise your prospects of continuing training.
- You will be bound to the results of the match.
- You cannot be matched to a Health Service that you have not selected and applied to.
- Do not list a site on your preference ranking where you would not be prepared to work.
- You can withdraw from the match until 3rd August 2020.
- Once matched, you will not be able to negotiate another appointment, or participate in another RACP specialty match. Please refer to the PMCV [Code of Conduct](#).
- Take care to ensure your preference-ranking list is accurate.

Health Services

- The deadline for Health Services to submit their preference ranking for the match is 4th August 2020.
- Ensure that you have accurately completed your ranking and number of positions to be filled under each category.
- The results of the match are binding on the Health Service.
- PMCV and VGMT cannot be held responsible for errors in the Health Service preference listing.

Notification

- Health services will notify successful applicants on 7th August 2020.
- VGMT will advise unsuccessful applicants.
- The results of the match will be available on the PMCV website from 10th August 2020.

The next steps

- Successful applicants will be contacted by the Health Services regarding employment contracts.
- VGMT will collate a list of unfilled positions after the match, if any.
- The option of a second round match will be considered after the match. At this stage, it is not anticipated that this will be necessary.
