



## Victorian Geriatric Medicine Training Program

### Centralised Match update - 21<sup>st</sup> June 2021

Registration for the first round of the centralised match opens on Friday 25<sup>th</sup> June.

- This round is for continuing advanced trainees including those transferring from other RACP specialty programs.
- New advanced trainees may apply for the second-round match that opens on 22<sup>nd</sup> July.

There are two important steps:

- Registration with the [Postgraduate Medical Council of Victoria](#).
- Applications for employment with health services

Key points:

- Registration with PMCV includes nomination of referees, CV and health service preferences.
- Registration for the first-round match closes on 4<sup>th</sup> July. This is the last day for you to add health services to your preference list.
- Referee reports submitted after 4<sup>th</sup> July cannot be accepted.
- You can reorder your preference list until 18<sup>th</sup> July, including deleting a health service from your list, but you are not permitted to add a new health service after 4<sup>th</sup> July.
- You may withdraw from match until 18<sup>th</sup> July, following which the results of the match are binding.
