### Centralised Match for Advanced Training in 2022

Update 28<sup>th</sup> June 2021

- Please follow each step and adhere to the deadlines.

**The first-round has commenced.**

- Details of the first-round match are summarised below.

**RACP has announced that the Clinical Examination results will be released on 7th October for candidates who sat in Victoria in 2021**

- The previously announced dates for the second-round match no longer apply.
- The second-round match will now commence on 6th August
- Health Services must list their reference rankings between 8th and 12th October.
- The match results should be available on 15th October.

#### First Round Match

- The PMCV website (<https://www.pmcv.com.au/aps>) opened for continuing advanced trainees to register for the first-round match on Friday 25th June. Application to register for the match closes on 4th July
- Part-time and job-share appointments may be negotiated before 5th July and the position removed from the match
- After 4th July, applicants will not be able to add a health service to their preference list.
- Referee reports submitted after 4th July will not be accepted.
- Applicants can reorder their preference lists, delete health services, or withdraw from the match until 18th July.
- After 5th July, site coordinators will have access to a list of approved trainees who have preference their health services, CVs and referees' reports.
- Site coordinators must submit their preferred applicants in rank order between 20th and 22nd July.
- The results of the match are expected to be available on 2nd August, and published on 5th August.
