Centralised Match for Advanced Training in 2022

24th August 2021

The deadline for registration with PMCV for the second round match closes this Friday 27th August at 5PM. It is also the closing date for you to add additional health services to your preference list, and for your referees to complete their reports.

It is safer to have a larger number of health services on your list. You are able to delete health services from your list until 8th October, but you won't be able to add any more. Your preference list does not need to be finalised until 8th October.

You cannot be matched to a health service unless you have included it on your PMCV list and submitted an application for employment with the health service. Please check the health service employment website for the closing date for application.

Geriatric Medicine is participating in the Combined Specialty Match.

Eligibility: New Advanced Trainees and current Advanced Trainees transferring from other specialties

Conditions: The results of the match are binding on both applicants and health services.

Ineligibility: You are ineligible to participate in this match if you have already been matched this year, or have accepted an another employment offer.
